Vallejo Community Access Television (VCAT) is a community media service organization that provides access to facilities, equipment, and training to produce and telecast television shows that interest or benefit all those who live and work in Vallejo.

VCAT is a non-profit organization in partnership with the City of Vallejo, the Vallejo City Unified School District, and Solano Community College.

VCAT began operating on Channel 27 March 1, 2006

As a member of VCAT you can learn to produce your own programs in the studio or out in the community!



Membership VCAT membership is open to all those who live or work in Vallejo. Membership is also open to organizations that serve Vallejo such as clubs, groups, non-profit organizations, businesses, government institutions, schools, colleges and universities. There are three basic membership categories, including Basic membership and two Producer categories. Membership as a Producer is required to use or to receive training for VCAT equipment or facilities. Producers may also serve as sponsors to submit programming from independent producers.

What VCAT Offers

- Facilities that include a studio and equipment to produce original television shows.
- Field Camera Units for use out in the community
- Digital editing stations with recent software
- Training and technical support for all equipment and software
- Training and creative support in video production
- A Community Bulletin Board for local groups, clubs and organizations
- Up to 30 hours a week of educational programming
- The opportunity to reflect and represent life in Vallejo
